**Physician Assistant Schedule II Prescribers
Identity To Be Provided To The Public**

POLICY: It is the policy of the Board of Licensure in Medicine that the database of Physician Assistants who have been granted Schedule II prescribing authority by the Board will be public information.

HISTORY: The identity of Physician Assistants who are authorized to prescribe Schedule II medications has been available only in a password-protected section of the Board's web site, for reference by interested parties such as pharmacists and credentialers. The identity of Physician Assistant prescribers of Schedule II medications is not confidential by statute or rule. The Board will be migrating to a new database in 2011, requiring a determination now of access to the data after conversion. The Physician Assistant Advisory Committee and the Board have agreed to make that information available to the general public on the Board's web site now and in the new data base conversion.
