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CONSENT AGREEMENT

This Consent Agreement is entered into between Cor de Hart, M.D., the State of Maine Board of Licensure in Medicine ("the Board") and the State of Maine Department of Attorney General pursuant to 10 M.R.S.A. § 8003(5)(B) and 32 M.R.S.A. § 3282-A.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Dr. de Hart was first licensed to practice medicine in the State of Maine in 1963. After practicing in Maine for several years, Dr. de Hart moved to Delaware. On May 15, 1992, Dr. de Hart submitted an application for renewal of his medical license in inactive status. In June, 1993, Dr. de Hart requested that his license be changed from inactive to active status. The Board issued an active medical license to Dr. de Hart on June 10, 1993. In July, 1993, the Board received an Adverse Action report from Eastern Maine Medical Center which informed the Board that Dr. de Hart's temporary privileges had been revoked by the hospital. The Board subsequently learned that Dr. de Hart was under investigation by the Delaware and Washington licensing authorities. These investigations began before Dr. de Hart moved to Maine and asked the Board to change his license from "inactive" to "active" status.

The Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Washington filed a Stipulation

and Agreed Order with respect to Dr. de Hart's license in October, 1993. Pursuant to that order, Dr. de Hart's license to practice medicine and surgery was placed on probation for three years and conditions were imposed on his practice of medicine. The Stipulation and Agreed Order was signed by Dr. de Hart in October, 1993.

In October, 1994, the Delaware Board of Medical Practice suspended Dr. de Hart's medical license for six years and placed permanent restrictions on his practice of medicine. This order was entered after a full adjudicatory hearing by the Delaware Board. The findings and orders of both the Delaware Board of Medical Practice and the Medical Disciplinary Board of the State of Washington are incorporated into this Consent Agreement and copies of these orders are attached. Both boards concluded that the allegations of unprofessional conduct against Dr. de Hart had been sustained.

In August, 1993, a public complaint was filed against Dr. de Hart. Dr. de Hart did not apply for renewal of his Maine medical license in 1994 and his license lapsed in July, 1994. In September, 1994, Dr. de Hart's license was administratively suspended for nonrenewal.

#### AGREEMENT

In lieu of proceeding to an adjudicatory hearing, Dr. de Hart agrees to the following:

1. The Board has jurisdiction over Dr. de Hart and over the disciplinary matter raised by the Complaint filed with the Board.
2. Dr. de Hart will not seek to renew his license to practice medicine in the

State of Maine and his license shall be deemed to have been permanently surrendered as of the date of this agreement. Dr. de Hart will not be relicensed by the Board or its successor, at any time in the future, to practice medicine in the State of Maine.

3. Dr. de Hart waives his right to a hearing before the Board or any court regarding the terms and conditions of this Consent Agreement.


4. Dr. de Hart has been advised of his right to seek legal counsel with respect to the terms of this agreement.

I, Cor de Hart, M.D., have read and understand the foregoing Consent Agreement. I understand that by signing it, I waive certain rights. I sign it voluntarily, without any threat or promise. I understand that this Consent Agreement contains the entire agreement and there is no other agreement of any kind.
