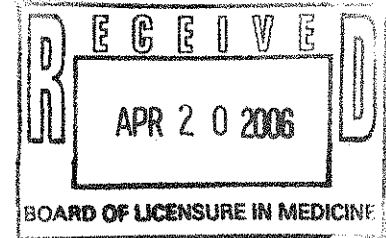

Dr. Serrage commenced the Adjudicatory Hearing at 1:10 P.M.

By letter dated June 15, 1988, sent Certified Mail, Return Receipt Requested, Dr. Howell was notified of today's Adjudicatory Hearing concerning the State Tax Assessor's notice to the Board that it may not reissue Dr. Howell's license.

Dr. Howell failed to attend or to be represented by counsel at the Adjudicatory Hearing.

The following Exhibits were received in evidence:

EXHIBIT 1A - Notice of Hearing dated June 15, 1988 telling Dr. Howell the purpose of the hearing and that it would begin at 1:00 P.M. at the Board office.

EXHIBIT 1B - Return receipt evidencing service the Notice of Hearing and receipt of it by Dr. Howell.

EXHIBIT 2 - Under seal of the State of Maine, the Acting State Assessor certified a number of documents as correct and true copies from the State Tax Assessor file. One of these documents is a notice dated April 15, 1988 informing Dr. Howell that on February 1, 1988 he was notified of a delinquency in filing Maine State Tax returns and that this notice alerted him that renewal of his Medical license would be denied by the Medical Board until the delinquencies were resolved. Dr. Howell was given notice of his right to appeal the Tax Assessor's decision. Attached to that is the

return receipt evidencing service of that document. Also attached is the June 10, 1988 letter from the State Tax Assessor to David Hedrick, Executive Director of the Board notifying the Board of the State Tax Assessor's determination, dated April 15, 1988, and that the decision now is final and that, in accordance with 36 M.R.S.A. Section 175 Sub. 3, the Board of Registration in Medicine must refuse to reissue, renew or otherwise extend Dr. Howell's license to practice in this state until further notice from the Bureau of Taxation.

ACTION - Motion was made, seconded and voted unanimously to refuse to renew the registration of the license of A. E. Howell, M.D. based on the finding of the Adjudicatory Hearing that the notices to Dr. Howell and the Board by the Maine State Tax Assessor comport with 36 M.R.S.A Section 175.
